O P I N I O N

H. A. Shelley, doing business as Wilmington Bus Company, applicant herein, has authority to render service as a passenger stage corporation over a specified route in the City of Los Angeles. By the above-numbered application, filed November 20, 1959, it seeks authority to render service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of pupils and employees of the Stephen White Junior High School, located at 22102 South Figueroa Street, Torrance, California, between said school on the one hand, and points and places within approximately one mile of said school on the other hand.

In lieu of designated routes, authority is requested to operate the service within the territory referred to via the most direct and appropriate routes. The schedules for said service will coincide with the opening and closing times of the school and the service is to be limited to the transportation of pupils and adult employees of the school. The proposed fares are 20 cents for adults, and 15 cents, or two tokens for a quarter, for students.

The service herein proposed has been in operation since September, 1958.

At the present time two trips are operated to the school in the morning, and from the school in the afternoon. Approximately 95 students and five adults are transported daily and the proposed fares are now in effect.

The Commission having considered the application, is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity require that the applicant provide service as a passenger stage corporation as set forth in the order herein. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

O R D E R

An application having been filed, the Commission having found that public convenience and necessity so require, and based on said finding,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity be, and it hereby is, granted to H. A. Shelley, doing business as Wilmington Bus Company, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of persons between the points and along the routes as set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof, subject to the conditions and restrictions, if any, as set forth in said Appendix A.

2. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed upon notice that he will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of his operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 98, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.
- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs and time-tables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Stephen White Junior High School Service

H. A. Shelley, by certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport persons between the Stephen White Junior High School located at 22102 South Figueroa Street, Torrance, California, and all points and places within the area bounded as follows:

On the north by 208th Street, on the south by Sepulveda Boulevard, on the east by Avalon Boulevard, and on the west by Western Avenue.

The service is subject to the following restriction:

Service shall be operated only on regular school days and shall be limited to the transportation of persons destined to or originating at the Stephen White Junior High School.
