
ORDER GRANTING STAY


Decision No. 59118 in the above matter ordered respondent to desist highway common carrier operations absent a certificate, and suspended his radial and contract permits for a twenty day period beginning the second Monday after the effective date of said decision. Petition for rehearing was filed in time to suspend the decision pending action on the petition. Rehearing was denied on February 1, 1960, and the decision became effective on that date.

In his petition for rehearing respondent requested that in the event of denial a stay be granted, indicating respondent's intent to petition for a writ of review; good cause appearing


IT IS ORDERED that the operative effect of Decision No. 59118 is hereby stayed pending further Commission order herein.
