BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of EVELYN M. KNAPP and JOHN P. DEMETER, co-partners doing business as PENINSULA TRANSIT LINES, for certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate passenger stage service between Palo Alto, North Palo Alto, San Carlos, Redwood City, Atherton, Menlo Park, Woodside and Toyon Knolls.

RE: Authority to revise certain routes in the vicinity of Palo Alto by reason of new underpass at Alma Street and Page Mill Road.

OPINION

Evelyn M. Knapp and John P. Demeter doing business as Peninsula Transit Lines request authority to amend their Route No. 1.

Applicants allege that the City of Palo Alto has revised its highway system in the area known as Alma Street, California Avenue and Page Mill Road by constructing various underpasses and overpasses affecting present highways and grade crossings of the Southern Pacific Company and as a consequence Route No. 1 should be amended as proposed.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

ROUTE NO. 2: Beginning at the Palo Alto Southern Pacific Depot and thence along Palm Drive, Lasuen Street, Serra Street, Lomita Drive, Santa Teresa Street, Mayfield Avenue to Anza Avenue, returning along Mayfield Avenue, Arguello Street, Serra Street, Lasuen Street, and Palm Drive to the Palo Alto Southern Pacific Depot.
