Application of THE GREYHOUND CORPORATION for authority to reroute passenger stage service between Vallejo and a point approximately 3½ miles north thereof over relocated California Highway 29.

<u>O P I N I O N</u>

By this application, filed on December 12, 1959, The Greyhound Corporation seeks authority to reroute its service in the Vallejo area in order to utilize relocated California Mighway 29 between a point near the northern city limits of Vallejo and a point approximately 3½ miles north thereof. This proposal will revise a segment of the applicant's presently authorized Route No. 7.01 between the above-mentioned points over former California Mighway 29.

Said highway has been improved and relocated as a fourlane highway between the above points and, it is alleged, the use of the new road will enable the applicant's buses to avoid the traffic congestion, intersections and railroad crossings at grade, and city street speed limitations now evident on the present segment. There will be no changes in the rates, frequency of service, or the number of units of equipment to be operated. With the exception of a railroad siding tariff point, designated as Flosden, to be eliminated, the currently effective tariffs of the applicant will continue to apply.

A public hearing does not appear to be necessary. No protest to this application has been received. After full consideration of the applicant's request, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted.

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Application having been made and the Commission being fully advised,

IT IS ORDERED:

 (1) That Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating First Revised Page 13 in revision of Original Page 13.

(2) That the authority herein granted is an extension and enlargement of, and consolidation with and subject to, all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893.

(3) That in providing service pursuant to the authority herein granted The Greyhound Corporation shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, The Greyhound Corporation shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.
- (b) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, The Greyhound Corporation

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shall file with the Commission appropriate map or maps consistent with the authority granted by this order.

ROUTE GROUP 7

*7.01 - Between Calistoga and Vallejo:

From Calistoga, over California Highway 29 to Vallejo.

7.02 - Between Calistoga and Mark West Road Junction:

From Calistoga, over unnumbered highway via Mark West Springs to junction U. S. Highway 101 (Mark West Road Junction).

7.03 - Between Santa Rosa and Shellville:

From Santa Rosa, over California Highway 12 to Warfield, thence over unnumbered highway via Glen Ellen, Madrone, Hanna Center School, and Agua Caliente to Agua Caliente Junction, thence over California Highway 12 to Verano, thence over unnumbered highway via El Verano to El Verano Junction, thence over California Highway 12 to Shellville.

7.04 - Between Warfield and Agua Caliente Junction:

From Warfield, over California Highway 12 to Agua Caliente Junction, to be operated as an alternate route.

7.05 - Between Verano and El Verano Junction:

From Verano, over California Highway 12 to El Verano Junction, to be operated as an alternate route.

7.06 - Between Napa and Four Corners:

From Napa, over California Highway 12 to Vineburg Junction, thence over unnumbered highway via Vineburg to junction California Highway 12 (Four Corners).
