The City of Pomona is authorized to construct Fourth
Street at grade across Southern Pacific Company's Chino Branch in
the City of Pomona, Los Angeles County, at the location described
in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BAB-515.6.
Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance
cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific
Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of
crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not
greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or
superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection
shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No.
75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,
