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BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a track across County Road in the County of Lassen, State of California.

Application No. 41769

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Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct, a relocated track at grade across Horse Lake Road near Ravendale, Lassen County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. CFA-395.7. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Upon completion of trackage relocation, applicant shall abandon existing County Road Crossing No. CFA-394.8 by physically removing rails from roadway and replacing trackage area with pavement.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

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Applicant, proposing to relocate its main line in this vicinity to eliminate excessive grades, desires to begin construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
