## <u>O R D E R</u>

County of Lassen is authorized to construct County Road 101 at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company near Westwood, Lassen County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AX-410.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with reflectorized "STOP ON RED SIGNAL" signs.

Upon completion, Crossing No. AX-410.8-B located about 400 feet northerly and an existing private crossing located about 100 feet southerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not

exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
