## ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

)

By Decisions Nos. 55358 and 58720 dated August 5, 1957 and July 7, 1959, respectively, in this proceeding, Lou-Jak Trucking Service, a corporation, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of specified commodities between the San Francisco Territory and Los Angeles and Vernon and between San Leandro and Riverbank.<sup>1</sup> The decisions ordered that in providing service, pursuant to the certificate therein granted, the carrier shall, within the period specified therein, establish the service and file and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

By letters dated July 16 and September 22, 1959, Lou-Jak Trucking Service was placed upon notice that, unless the service was established and the tariffs filed immediately, the certificate granted by the aforesaid decisions may be suspended or revoked pursuant to lawful procedures.

Lou-Jak Trucking Service, a corporation, is the successor to Louis Joaquin and Jack Rexelle, doing business as Lou-Jak Trucking Service.

The Commission being of the opinion and finding that the failure of Lou-Jak Trucking Service to file tariffs constitutes good cause for revocation of the certificate,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted Lou-Jak Trucking Service, a corporation, by Decision No. 55358, dated August 5, 1957, as amended by Decision No. 58720, dated July 7, 1959, in Application No. 35609, is hereby revoked.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Lou-Jak Trucking Service, a corporation.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after such service thereof upon Lou-Jak Trucking Service, a corporation, unless before such effective date it shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
