authority to abandon passenger  
stage service.

O P I N I O N

By this application, filed February 3, 1960, Ruby E. Ellis and W. P. Scarbrough, doing business as Big Creek Stages, request authority to discontinue passenger stage service between Fresno and Prather, Auberry, Shaver Lake, Camp Sierra, Big Creek, Huntington Lake, Lakeshore and Mono Hot Springs and intermediate points.

It is alleged that the passenger revenue in 1959 amounted to \$407.05; that insurance alone amounted to \$363.13; that their single vehicle is worn out and that they no longer have the mail contract to Mono Hot Springs.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicants' passenger stage service between the above-mentioned points. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

## IT IS ORDERED:

1. That on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Ruby E. Ellis and W. P. Scarbrough may discontinue

passenger stage service between Fresno and Prather, Auberry, Shaver Lake, Camp Sierra, Big Creek, Huntington Lake, Lakeshore and Mono Hot Springs and intermediate points.

2. That concurrently with the discontinuance of service all tariffs and time tables presently on file with this Commission in applicants' name are canceled.

3. That concurrently with the discontinuance of service the operative rights created by Decision No. 50249, dated July 6, 1954, in Application No. 35557 are hereby revoked.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
