O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Fillmore Street near Thermal, Riverside County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-619.0-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that the industry is in urgent need of early rail service and consequently requests waiver of the 20-day waiting period. The effective date of this order shall therefore be the date hereof.
