O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Tenth Street in the City of Marysville, Yuba County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. C-141.1.

Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. Protection for the additional spur track shall be by the existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B), which shall be reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant has advised that industry desires service as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
