ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 54877 dated April 22, 1957 the Commission authorized Palomar Stage Lines, Inc. to acquire ownership of the passenger stage operative rights owned by Homer Heller, acquired by him pursuant to the authority of the Commission's Decision No. 39249 as amended by Decision No. 41514 in Application No. 29254. This operative right authorized transportation of passengers, baggage, and shipments of express weighing not in excess of 100 pounds each on passenger carrying vehicles between Escondido and Oceanside and intermediate points, subject to local restrictions.

Palomar Stage Lines, Inc. has notified the Commission that service was discontinued on February 1, 1960. Service is now being rendered by the City of Oceanside.

The liability insurance required by General Order No. 101 expired March 27, 1960, and his certificate was, therefore, suspended on that date. Under these circumstances this carrier's certificate should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Decision No. 54877 dated April 22, 1957, in Application No. 38856 and all operating rights owned and possessed by

Palomar Stage Lines, Inc. authorizing passenger stage service between Escondido and Oceanside, California, are hereby revoked and all effective timetables and tariffs on file are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Palomar Stage Lines, Inc. in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
