SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 58342, dated May 5, 1959, Lapis Road Crossing (No. EE-114.1) of the Southern Pacific Company Monterey branch line was ordered closed by the construction of physical barriers to prevent the use by vehicular traffic.

It now appearing that a private crossing situation exists at this location involving access of adjacent land owners to their property,

IT IS ORDERED that the following paragraph be substituted in place of the first ordering paragraph of Decision No. 58342:

"IT IS ORDERED that the grade crossing of Lapis Road and the Monterey branch line of Southern Pacific Company designated as Crossing No. EE-114.1 be, and it hereby is, ordered closed to public use."

In all other respects Decision No. 58342 shall remain in full force and effect.
