ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

The liability insurance policy of N. E. M. Lines, Inc., lapsed as of January 31, 1960. Evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A not being on file, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of certificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier authorized by Decision No. 47469, dated July 15, 1952, in Application No. 31681, and acquired by N. E. M. Lines, Inc., by Decision No. 50290, dated July 20, 1954, in Application No. 35515, is hereby suspended pending further order.

(2) All tariffs issued by or on behalf of N. E. M. Lines, Inc., are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause personal service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon N. E. M. Lines, Inc.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date N. E. M. Lines, Inc., shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
