ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Hollow Rod of California, a corporation, has not filed evidence of liability protection required by General Order No. 100A, and the Commission being of the opinion and finding that such failure constitutes good cause for suspension of certificates and of tariffs applicable to services thereunder,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by Hollow Rod of California, a corporation, by Decision No. 58597, dated June 16, 1959, in Application No. 41099, is hereby suspended pending further order.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Hollow Rod of California, a corporation, are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause personal service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Hollow Rod of California, a corporation, and to mail a copy of this order to C. R. Nickerson, Agent.

The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Hollow Rod of California, a corporation, shall have filed with this Commission

evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
