IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier acquired by Douglas Oil Co. of California, a corporation, by Decision No. 58966, dated September 1, 1959, in Application No. 41278, is hereby suspended pending further order.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Douglas Oil Co. of California, a corporation, are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to cause personal service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Douglas Oil Co. of California, a corporation, and to mail a copy of this order to Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent.

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The effective date of this order shall be the fifth day after such service, unless before such effective date Douglas Oil Co. of California, a corporation, shall have filed with this Commission evidence of insurance protection as required by General Order No. 100A, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
