O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Tidelands Avenue, in the City of National City, San Diego County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-273.0-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No.75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion, Crossing No. 2-273.15-C, approximately 160 feet southerly, shall be abandoned and the rails thereof physically removed from Tidelands Avenue, with roadway restored to equivalent standard on either approach.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
