ORDER FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE OF DECISION NO. 58794


Decision No. 58794 provides in part for the suspension of the operating rights of respondent William R. Johnson "for five days starting at 12:01 a.m. on the second Monday following the effective date of this order." Respondent's petition for rehearing indicated that review would be sought in the event of denial, and for this reason the order denying rehearing stayed the effective date of Decision No. 58794 until further order of the Commission.


Petition for writ of review was denied by the Supreme Court on March 30, 1960. (Johnson v. Public Utilities Commission, S.F. No. 20310.)


Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the effective date of Decision No. 58794 shall be the date hereof.
