ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 37251 dated August 2, 1944, in Application No. 26244, Horace Coniglio was authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between the City of Pittsburg and east to the area of Pittsburg and intermediate points; that, during the month of March 1960 Horace Coniglio, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between Pittsburg and East Pittsburg pursuant to the foregoing described operative right; that, since April 1, 1960 Horace Coniglio has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101; and that Horace Coniglio has expressed his desire to discontinue service due to financial reasons and ill health.

Therefore, it is hereby found that Horace Coniglio is no longer conducting and in fact has abandoned passenger stage operations between Pittsburg and East Pittsburg and intermediate points.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 37251 in Application No. 26244, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Horace Coniglio are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Horace Coniglio.

The effective date of this order shall be five days after service thereof upon said Horace Coniglio unless he shall have filed with the Commission a response to this order, in writing, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
