ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one side track and one crossover across "D" Street, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EH-312.6; to construct one side track across "A" Street and along Laurel Avenue, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EH-312.8; and to remove the crossover from the trackage in "E" Street, Crossing No. EH-312.5, in the City of Lompoc, Santa Barbara County, as described and in the manner as shown in the application.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection at each of the above crossings shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material, with appropriate signs attached thereto to denote the number of tracks.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
