Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 12th Street, in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6LD-1.99-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction end maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.
