FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 59296, dated November 24, 1959, the City of Fullerton was authorized to construct Nicolas Avenue at grade across the Anaheim Branch of Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company and its Lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, in the City of Fullerton, Orange County.


In its petition for modification, the City of Fullerton states that it has become necessary to realign the proposed extension of North Nicolas Avenue to conform with subsequent Orange County plans.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the first sentence of Decision No. 59296 be amended to read as follows:

The City of Fullerton is authorized to construct Nicolas Avenue at grade across the Anaheim Branch of Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company and its Lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, hereinafter referred to as Union Pacific Railroad, in the City of Fullerton, at the location described in the petition for modification filed on February 29, 1960, to be identified as Crossing No. 3Y-13.6.

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In all other respects Decision No. 59296 shall remain in full force and effect.
