O R D E R

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to construct Pepper Avenue at separated grades over Southern Pacific Company's El Paso Route, near the City of Colton, San Bernardino County, at the location described and in the manner as shown in the application as amended March 22, 1960, to be identified as Crossing No. B-537.2-A.

Clearances shall be in conformance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D as modified by Decision No. 51251, dated March 29, 1955.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne by applicant. Plans of said structure, approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
