ORDER MODIFYING DECISION

Joseph M. Stadler and Claire A. Stadler, by Decision No. 57803 dated December 30, 1958, pursuant to the above application, were granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in the subdivision known as Skywood Acres, San Mateo County. The decision contained the following requirement in ordering paragraph 2:

"2. Applicants may sell not to exceed 53,500 cubic feet of water per month to Skyline Village Water Co., a mutual water company, provided however that no more than 3,400 cubic feet shall be delivered in any one day."

By letter received April 8, 1960, applicants have requested that they be permitted to increase the amount of water that may be sold to Skyline Village Water Co. to 66,800 cubic feet per month. As a basis for this request, applicants cite a well test dated June 15, 1959, the results of which are attached to the letter received April 8, 1960, from which it appears that an adequate supply of water will be available for the proposed increased deliveries to Skyline Village Water Co. in addition to supplying the utility's other customers.

The Commission has considered this matter and finds that Decision No. 57803 should be modified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph 2 of Decision No. 57803, dated December 30, 1958, in Application No. 40223, be and it is revised to read as follows:

"2. Applicants may sell not to exceed 66,800 cubic feet of water per month to Skyline Village Water Co., a mutual water company, provided however that no more than 4,250 cubic feet shall be delivered in any one day."

Except as modified by this order, Decision No. 57803 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
