ORDER VACATING SUSPENSION OF OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Decision No. 59954, dated April 19, 1960, in this proceeding, provided for the suspension of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of Vernon W. Bolen, dba Bolen's Delivery Service, unless prior to the effective date of that decision it shall have filed evidence of adequate liability insurance, in which event the order would be stayed. The effective date of the decision was April 30, 1960, on which date the certificate became suspended. Vernon W. Bolen filed the required evidence of insurance on May 4, 1960, retroactive to March 19, 1960. Inasmuch as evidence of adequate insurance is now on file, the order of suspension in Decision No. 59954, supra, will be vacated and the rights under its certificate to operate as a highway common carrier will be reinstated.

Vernon W. Bolen is hereby placed on notice that operations conducted without adequate evidence of insurance being on file with this Commission is a violation of General Order No. 100A. The carrier is reminded that the filing of evidence of insurance with a retroactive effective date to cover all or a portion of the period when evidence of insurance protection was not on file with the Commission does not meet the requirements of that general order.

In the event he should operate in the future without having evidence of liability insurance on file with the Commission, consideration will be given to possible penalty or other action.
