ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 60016

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering paragraph 1 of Decision No. 60016, issued April 26, 1960, be and it hereby is amended by substituting the letter "O" for the letter "N" in the last line of said paragraph.
2. Ordering paragraph 2 of said decision be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"2. California Water & Telephone Company is specifically authorized to install facilities and extend service in the properties described herein as Halecrest Estates Unit A and the FAMA portion and the balance of Judson Estates Unit No. 3, pursuant to and in accordance with the contract identified herein as Exhibit I with respect to Halecrest Estates Unit A, the contract identified herein as Exhibit N with respect to FAMA portion and the contract identified herein as Exhibit O with respect to the balance, of Judson Estates Unit No. 3."
