<u>OPINION</u>

Bekins Warehousing Corp. requests authority to discontinue public warehouse operations at 1375 East 8th Street, Oakland, California.

It is alleged that the lessor from whom applicant leased 5,000 square feet of space at this location has sold the property; that applicant has space available at 2227 San Pablo Avenue, Oakland, California, to handle commercial storage; that for the past year and a half no storage has been offered to applicant nor has applicant stored any commodities at 1375 East 8th Street.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's service as a public warehouseman at 1375 East 8th Street, Oakland. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That after the effective date hereof Bekins Warehousing Corp. may discontinue operations as a public warehouseman in 5,000 square feet of space located at 1375 East 8th Street, Oakland, California.

(2) That on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its tariffs on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
