BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SACRAMENTO NORTHERN RAILWAY for authority to abandon certain non-agency stations and to remove certain spur and side tracks located at such non-agency stations.

O R D E R

The verified application of Sacramento Northern Railway filed on April 15, 1960 discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's stations of Willow Point and Silverdale both in Yolo County, California, during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintenance.

Notice of the application has been given to various parties thought to be interested and no protests have been received. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

Good cause appearing Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Willow Point and Silverdale, both in Yolo County; to remove facilities at said stations as set forth in the application; to eliminate said names from their station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
