SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 59304, dated November 24, 1959, in this proceeding, authorized William S. Rozay, doing business as Rozay's Transfer, to depart from the provisions of Item No. 165 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 for the services of unloading property tendered in pool cars for Burlington Industries, Inc., of Los Angeles. The authority is scheduled to expire December 14, 1960.

By this supplemental application, filed May 23, 1960, authority is sought to substitute, effective June 7, 1960, Rozay's Transfer, a California corporation, in place and stead of William S. Rozay, doing business as Rozay's Transfer, in the current deviation authority. A certified copy of the Articles of Incorporation, effective April 27, 1960, is attached to the supplemental application.

Applicant states that the corporation proposes to continue handling the shipments of Burlington Industries, Inc., under the rate relief granted by Decision No. 59304, supra.

The sought authority will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,




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
In all other respects, said Decision No. 59304 shall remain in full force and effect.
