ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier granted to Charlie Snapp by Decision No. 45423, dated March 6, 1951, in Application No. 31984, as amended by Decision No. 48612, dated May 19, 1953, in Application No. 34275, is hereby suspended pending further order.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Charlie Snapp, dba Snapp's Auto Stage, are hereby suspended pending further order. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.
