SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 60318 entered today, the
 Commission amended Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 by adding an exception
 rating of fourth class on less than carload shipments of "Candy
 Coating, other than Chocolate." In accordance with that decision,
 Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 will be amended by a separate order to
 avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision
 No. 32504, as amended) is hereby further amended by incorporating
 therein to become effective August 19, 1960, Fifth Revised Page 3
 and Sixth Revised Page 22, which revised pages are attached hereto
 and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common
 carriers as a result of the order herein may be filed not earlier
 than the effective date hereof, and may be made effective on not
 less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if
 filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the
 minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. Common carriers be, and they are authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution, and Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code, to the extent necessary to adjust long-and-short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; that such outstanding authorizations be and they are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and that schedules containing the rating published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long-and-short-haul departures and to this order.

4. In all other respects said Decision No. 32504, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
