ORDER

City of Vallejo is authorized to construct Redwood Street at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company in Vallejo, Solano County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AAB-66.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 60 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two cantilever type Standard No. 8 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B). Upon installation of traffic signals at the nearby intersection of Redwood Street and Broadway as contemplated in the application, said traffic signals shall be pre-empted when railroad train, locomotive or car movements occur at Crossing No. AAB-66.1.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
