Joint Application of the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, and UNION PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY, a corporation, for an order to modify Application No. 40286 crossing protection of various crossings and to close and abandon to public use certain other crossings in the City of Riverside, California. SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER By Decision No. 57971 in Case No. 6197 and in Application No. 40286 the Commission made certain findings which included the finding that public safety and health required that Crossing No. 2B-19.0 (Fillmore Street) in the County of Riverside on The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company be closed as soon as the freeway in the vicinity of this crossing was completed. The freeway has now been completed, but it now appears that this crossing is the sole access to certain property located on Fillmore Street between the railroad and the freeway. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company by letter dated May 27, 1960, has indicated that it would have no objection if this crossing were permitted to remain open. Therefore, good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That the finding contained in Decision No. 57971 to the effect that Crossing No. 2B-19.0, Fillmore Street, be closed is hereby annulled.
- 2. That the respondent County of Riverside and The Atchison,
  Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company are relieved from the requirement
  of closing Crossing No. 2B-19.0, Fillmore Street.

In all other respects Decision No. 57971 is in full force and effect.
