O P I N I O N

Sierra Warehouse Corp. requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a public warehouseman in the City of Tracy.

The proposed operations would be conducted at 450 East Grant Line Road, Tracy. Said property consists of 68,000 square feet of building area and three acres of open storage area. The buildings are of wooden frame construction, with sheet steel roofs and exteriors and concrete floors. Applicant proposes to dedicate 19,200 square feet of the building area.

It is alleged that applicant has conducted a private warehouse service for over two years; that since the inception the operation has grown and expanded because of an ever increasing demand for such service; that applicant has been reluctant to meet this demand without the proper operating authority; and that to applicant's knowledge there is no general commodity public utility warehouse facility available in the area.

As of December 31, 1959, applicant indicated a net worth of \$29,104.98 and realized a net profit of \$15,287.08 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 1959.

After consideration, the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Sierra Warehouse Corp. authorizing the operation of 19,200 square feet of warehouse floor space in the City of Tracy for the storage of property as a public utility warehouseman.

2. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
