O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct the east roadway of Haven Avenue (State Route 190-A) at grade across a spur track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company near the community of Alta Loma, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2-99.75-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall not be less than 32 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), with reflex reflecting sheet material, installed on approach side.

Applicant is further authorized to widen Highland Avenue (Crossing No. 2-99.8-C) substantially as described in the application and as shown on Exhibit "C" attached thereto. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
