ORDER OF MODIFICATION

It is alleged that Warehouse Tariff No. 1 Cal. P.U.C. No. 1 was inadvertently filed with this Commission by James P. Nielsen as president of Nielsen Freight Lines, rather than as an individual doing business as Nielsen Warehouse. James P. Nielsen, doing business as Nielsen Warehouse, will be authorized to adopt the tariff filed by Nielsen Freight Lines, a corporation. This authorization is not to be construed as a determination of warehouse operative rights, if any, held by either Nielsen Freight Lines, a corporation, or James P. Nielsen, an individual, doing business as Nielsen Warehouse.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, James P. Nielsen, doing business as Nielsen Warehouse, may supplement or amend Warehouse Tariff No. 1, Cal. P.U.C. No. 1, issued by Nielsen Freight Lines, a corporation, naming rates, rules and regulations governing warehouse operations, to show that Nielsen Freight Lines, a corporation, has withdrawn and

that James P. Nielsen, doing business as Nielsen Warehouse, has established as his own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filing made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
