O R D E R

The City of Redlands is authorized to construct First Street at grade across Southern Pacific Company's Redlands Branch in the City of Redlands, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BP-547.71. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material, with appropriate signs attached thereto to denote the number of tracks. Applicant shall also cause to have installed, two 20,000 lumen overhead lights as described in the application and as shown on Exhibit "D" attached thereto.

Upon completion, Crossing No. BP-547.7 about 200 feet westerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after

completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
