O P I N I O N

The Greyhound Corporation requests authority to establish an additional urban route within the City of San Diego extending from the junction of Main Street and Twenty-Eighth Street, over Twenty-Eighth Street to Harbor Drive.

The proposed route is over an access highway connecting applicant's urban Route UR-12.10 over Main Street with applicant's urban Route UR 12.09 over an expressway at Twenty-Eighth Street and extends for a distance of slightly more than one block.

It is alleged that there has been a public demand that applicant's express schedules serve points in San Diego along Market Street; that to meet this demand it will be necessary to use the Twenty-Eighth Street access between Main Street and the expressway.

After consideration the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that

term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Second Revised Page 80, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 55893 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

2. Appendix A of Decision No. 55893 is hereby amended by incorporating Second Revised Page 80.

3. In providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

- UR-12.10 - From junction Broadway and Front Street, over Front Street to Market Street to Twelfth Avenue to National Avenue to Twenty-Sixth Street to Main Street to the City Limits of San Diego, en route to San Ysidro.
- UR-12.11 - From junction Fifth Avenue and Market Street, over Fifth Avenue to Harbor Drive.
- UR-12.12 - From junction First Avenue and F Street, over F Street to junction California Highway 94, en route to El Centro.
- UR-12.13 - Entering San Diego on California Highway 94, en route from El Centro, over G Street to First Avenue.
- *UR-12.14 - From junction Main Street and Twenty-Eighth Street, over Twenty-Eighth Street to junction Harbor Drive.
