FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern California Edison Company having requested the Commission to clarify the order in Decision No. 60522, dated August 9, 1960, with respect to the disposition of the proceeds from the sale of the \$60,000,000 of bonds authorized by the decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 4 of the order in Decision No. 60522, dated August 9, 1960, reading as follows:

4. Southern California Edison Company shall use the proceeds from the sale of said bonds for the purpose of paying outstanding indebtedness and of reimbursing its treasury. The accrued interest may be used for said purposes or for general corporate purposes.




be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

4. Southern California Edison Company shall use the proceeds from the sale of said bonds, after payment and discharge of obligations incurred for expenses incident to their issue and sale, to retire and discharge promissory notes which may be outstanding as of the date of receipt of such proceeds and to reimburse it for monies actually expended from income or from

any other money in its treasury not secured by or obtained from the issue of stocks or stock certificates or other evidence of interest or ownership, or bonds, notes or other evidences of indebtedness, for the acquisition of property, construction, completion, extension or improvement of its facilities, exclusive of maintenance of service and replacements. The accrued interest may be used for said purposes or for general corporate purposes.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that this first Supplemental Order will become effective on the date hereof.
