OFDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

By Decision No. 37491, dated November 21, 1944, in this proceeding, John F. Conway, Jr., Ruth Freese Conway, Albert C. Freese, Gertrude S. Freese and Richard F. Mogan, doing business as Transit Service Co., were granted a permit to operate as a for-hire vessel carrier for the transportation of molasses in bulk, under contracts with certain shippers from Point San Fablo to Sausalito and Collinsville and from ships on San Francisco Bay and its tributaries to Point San Pablo.

Recent notices addressed to Transit Service Co. at their latest known address have been returned unclaimed. The Commission has been informed that Gertrude S. Freese and Richard F. Mogan are deceased, and that "it will be in order to cancel the 'For Hire' Vessel Permit of the Transit Service Co. which has been inactive since 1946."

On basis of these facts the Commission finds that the operations authorized by the permit herein involved have been abandoned.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the for-hire vessel permit issued to John F. Conway, Jr., Ruth Freese Conway, Albert C. Freese, Gertrude S. Freese and Richard F. Mogan, doing business as Transit Service Co., by Decision No. 37491, dated November 21, 1944, in Application No. 26295, is hereby revoked.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Transit Service Co. are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon John F. Conway, Jr., Ruth Freese Conway and Albert C. Freese.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service upon John F. Conway, Jr., Ruth Freese Conway or Albert C. Freese, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, or requesting public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of this Commission.
