SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER





On March 24, 1959, in Decision No. 58183, the Commission entered an Interim Opinion and Order in this proceeding authorizing applicants to increase passenger fares. Said authority is scheduled to expire September 1, 1960. Further hearings in this proceeding were held commencing August 24, 1960 and the matter of the fare structures of applicants, as well as The Greyhound Corporation, is presently before the Commission. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the time within which the authority granted by the order in Decision No. 58183 may be exercised is

extended until such time as it may be terminated by further order
in this proceeding.
