O P I N I O N

Applicant, whose headquarters are in Los Angeles, operates an extensive sightseeing service in Southern California along with certain other services. By the instant application, filed April 8, 1960, it seeks authority to operate a sightseeing tour between Riverside, on the one hand, and Knotts Berry Farm, Disneyland, and Newport-Balboa, on the other hand. The three last-named areas are important points of interest both to tourists and residents in Southern California.

Applicant proposes to employ de luxe, reclining-seat buses. Service would be round trip only, at a fare of \$7.00 plus federal tax. No intermediate point service is proposed. There will be time allotted at the tourist points for meals and sightseeing.

Applicant alleges that it has received requests for this type of service from the City Manager and Chamber of Commerce of Riverside and from many business groups, especially hotels. There have been no protests to the application. It appears and the Commission finds and concludes that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed, the Commission having considered the same and being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., authorizing it to operate as a passenger stage corporation as defined by Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between the points and over the routes particularly set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. In providing service pursuant to the operating authority herein granted Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- a. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98 and insurance requirements of the Commission's General Order No. 101. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Orders Nos. 98 and 101, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.
- b. Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant

shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective, tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage in sightseeing service between:

Riverside territory, on the one hand, and on the other hand, Newport Beach-Balboa, Knotts Berry Farm and Disneyland territories, all four of said territories as described below,

subject to the following conditions:

- (a) All persons must be transported on a round-trip or circular tour basis originating in the City of Riverside.
- (b) Applicant shall pick up and discharge passengers only at principal hotels or motels to be named in applicant's tariff.
- (c) Subject to the authority of this Commission to change or modify such passenger stage operation at any time, Tanner Motor Tours, Ltd., shall conduct said operation over and along the following described main routes:

Beginning at the Riverside territory; thence southwesterly along U.S. Highway 91 to the City of Anaheim; thence (1) along the most appropriate highways and thoroughfares to the Disneyland territory, along the most appropriate highways and thoroughfares to Knotts Berry Farm territory or alternately; (2) along the most appropriate highways and thoroughfares to Knotts Berry Farm territory, along the most appropriate highways and thoroughfares to Disneyland territory; along the most appropriate highways and thoroughfares to U.S. Highway 101, southeasterly along U.S. Highway 101 to its intersection with State Highway 55, southwesterly along State Highway 55 to the Newport Beach-Balboa territory, northwesterly along U.S. Highway 101 Alternate to its intersection with State Highway 39, northerly along State Highway 39 to its intersection with Imperial Highway, easterly along Imperial

Highway to Brea Canyon Road, northeasterly along Brea Canyon Road to the City of Pomona, southeasterly along State Highway 71 to its intersection with U.S. Highway 91, northeasterly along U.S. Highway 91 to point of beginning; or alternately beginning at the Riverside territory; thence following the reverse of the routing hereinabove set forth to point of beginning.

The territories referred to hereinabove are described as follows:

RIVERSIDE TERRITORY includes that territory located within the city limits of the City of Riverside, California.

KNOTTS BERRY FARM TERRITORY includes all that area in Orange County, California, located within the following boundary: Beginning at the intersection of Knotts Avenue and Houston Avenue; then easterly along Houston Avenue to Dale Avenue; southerly along Dale Avenue to Lincoln Avenue (State Highway No. 18); westerly along Lincoln Avenue to Knotts Avenue; northerly along Knotts Avenue to point of beginning.

DISNEYLAND TERRITORY includes all that area in Orange County, California, located within the following boundary: Beginning at the intersection of Ball Road and Euclid Avenue, thence along Euclid Avenue to the Santa Ana Freeway; southeasterly along the Santa Ana Freeway to Katella Avenue; westerly along Katella Avenue to Harbor Boulevard; southerly along Harbor Boulevard to Orangewood Avenue; westerly along Orangewood Avenue to Euclid Avenue, northerly along Euclid Avenue to the point of beginning.

NEWPORT BEACH-BALBOA TERRITORY includes all that area in Orange County, California, located within the following boundary: Commencing at the intersection of the Pacific Ocean and the southwesterly prolongation of McArthur Boulevard, thence northeasterly and northerly along McArthur Boulevard to Palisade Road, northwesterly along Palisade Road to Newport Boulevard, southwestwesterly along Newport Boulevard to Victoria, westerly along Victoria to Wright Street, southerly along Wright Street and its southerly prolongation to the Pacific Ocean, southeasterly along the shore line of the Pacific Ocean to the point of beginning.
