BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application of the State of California,
 Department of Public Works, for an order
 authorizing construction of two crossings
 at separated grades whereby State Route
 VIII-Riv-19-Riv,B, will be carried over
 the San Bernardino to Fullerton mainline
 track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa
 Fe Railway Company and over the Riverside
 branch track of the Southern Pacific
 Company, and the up-grading of the pro-
 tection of an existing crossing at grade,
 in the City of Riverside, hereinafter
 referred to as "Down Street Overhead"
 and "Chicago Avenue Overhead".

ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct State Route 19 (U.S. Highway 60) at separated grades over tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company, in the City of Riverside, Riverside County, as described in Exhibit "A" and at the location and in the manner as shown in Exhibit "B" attached to the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 2B-8.7-A and BJ-544.7-A, respectively.

Clearances shall be in conformance with the provisions of General Order No. 26-D for both structures, and Decision No. 50807, dated November 30, 1954, as said decision would relate to Crossing No. 2B-8.7-A.

In connection with the construction of the Chicago Avenue separation structure, applicant and Southern Pacific Company shall

install two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). at Chicago Avenue (Crossing No. BJ-544.8) prior to the commencement of the separation structure.

Construction and maintenance costs shall be borne in accordance with the terms of an agreement to be entered into between the parties and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans approved by the railroads, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencement of construction.

Within thirty days after completion of the structures and grade crossing protection improvement, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
