OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, filed August 15, 1960, Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau seeks authority to make Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau Tariff 33-R effective on California intrastate traffic. The tariff in question provides rail rates for the transportation of ore, metals and mill or smelter products. It was made effective May 15, 1960, on interstate traffic.

Establishment of the tariff for application on intrastate traffic as proposed would result in some increases in rates and charges. From the application it appears, however, that the increases are minor and of little or no practical significance.

The application states that this proposal was widely publicized in trade magazines and was distributed to a mailing list of known interested persons. No objection to the proposal was received.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the proposed increases are justified. A public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Pacific Southcoast Freight Bureau is hereby authorized to establish the tariff provisions as proposed in the above-entitled application.

(2) That the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within ninety days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
