SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Osborn Trucking Company, a corporation, is authorized to operate as a petroleum irregular route carrier between all points and places in California. On September 22, 1960, it filed its amended articles of incorporation changing its corporate name to Las Vegas Service Freightways. Accordingly, its certificate will be amended to show the new corporate name and it will be ordered to amend its tariffs and powers of attorney on file with the Commission. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Decision No. 50710 dated October 26, 1954, in Application No. 35781, is hereby amended by substituting "Las Vegas Service Freightways" in place of "Osborn Trucking Company" only insofar as that decision pertains to the petroleum irregular route carrier operating rights granted by Decision No. 44469.

(2) That within ninety days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall supplement or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations governing the common carrier operations here involved to show that Osborn Trucking

Company has withdrawn or canceled, and Las Vegas Service Freightways has adopted or established as its own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
