## ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 33332, dated July 9, 1950, in this proceeding, Robert A. Grimes was granted a permit to operate as a for-hire vessel carrier for the transportation of members of the crew of the steamship "Columbus" from Pier 32 in San Francisco to Angel Island under contract with the German Consulate General.

Recent notices addressed to this carrier at his latest known address have been returned unclaimed. There have been no amendments to his for-hire vessel tariff since 1940.

In the circumstances, it appears that the for-hire vessel service has been abandoned and the permit and tariff should be revoked and canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the for-hire vessel permit issued to Robert A. Grimes by Decision No. 33332, dated July 9, 1950, in Application No. 23558, is hereby revoked.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Robert A. Grimes are hereby canceled. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Robert A. Grimes at his last known address as shown in the Commission records.
