CRDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Docision No. 48548, dated April 28, 1953, in this proceeding, James J. Criel, doing business as Humboldt Bay Tugboat Company, was granted a permit to operate a tugboat as a for-hire vessel carrier for the towing of barges loaded with lumber, logs, pile drivers or cranes between certain points on Humboldt Bay.

Recent notices addressed to this carrier at his latest known address have been returned unclaimed. There have been no amendments to his for-hire vessel tariff since 1953.

In the circumstances, it appears that the for-hire vessel service has been abandoned and the permit and tariff should be revoked and canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the for-hire vessel permit issued to James J. Criol, doing business as Humboldt Bay Tugboat Company, by Decision No. 48548, dated April 28, 1953, in Application No. 35014, 13 hereby revoked.
- (2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of James J. Criel, doing business as Humboldt Bay Tugboat Company, are hereby canceled. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to James J. Criel at his last known address as shown in the Commission records.

The effective date of this order shall be the thirtieth day after the above mailing to James J. Criel unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein, or requesting public hearing, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of this Commission.
