ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 38388, dated November 13, 1945, in this proceeding, Lee E. Waggoner was granted a permit to operate as a for-hire vessel carrier for the transportation of ships' stores and supplies for the War Shipping Administration between San Francisco and ships on San Francisco Bay.

Recent notices addressed to this carrier at his latest known address have been returned unclaimed. There have been no amendments to his for-hire vessel tariff since 1945.

In the circumstances, it appears that the for-hire vessel service has been abandoned and the permit and tariff should be revoked and canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That the for-hire vessel permit issued to Lee E. Waggoner by Decision No. 38388, dated November 13, 1915, in Application No. 27081, is hereby revoked.

(2) That all tariffs issued by or on behalf of Lee E. Waggoner are hereby canceled. A copy of this order shall be filed with said tariffs in the office of the Commission.

The Secretary is directed to mail a certified copy of this order to Lee E. Waggoner at his last known address as shown in the Commission records.
