SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

It appearing that through inadvertence there were three errors in commodity descriptions on Original Page 1 of Appendix A of Decision No. 60658 which should be corrected, as follows:

1. Item 7 refers to "Exception Sheet No. 1-5" but should refer to "Exception Sheet No. 1-S";
2. Item 9 refers to "Seeds as described in Note 6 of Items 41-42" but should read "Items 40-41"; and
3. Since applicant does not wish to include the transportation of "fertilizer, aqua ammonia" an Item 11 of exceptions should be added: "11. Aqua ammonia fertilizer, liquid, when transported in bulk in tank vehicles";

therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said Decision No. 60658 is amended by deleting Original Page 1 of Appendix A to said decision and by incorporating in its stead First Revised Page 1 as attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof.

Appendix A ASSOCIATED TRANSPORTATION CO., INC. First Revised Page 1  
 ( a corporation ) Cancels  
 Original Page 1

Associated Transportation Co., Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities with the exception of:

1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
2. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
3. Nuts, edible, in shells.
4. Fruit and vegetables, dried, unmanufactured and unprocessed.
5. Fresh fruits and vegetables when point of destination is a cannery, accumulation station, cold storage plant, precooling plant or winery.
6. Insecticides and fungicides, agricultural.
7. Fertilizers as described in Items Nos. 535, 540 and 550 of Exception Sheet No. 1-S, Cal. P.U.C. No. 193, J. P. Haynes, Agent.
8. Sulphur.
9. Seeds as described in Note 6 of Items 40-41 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.
10. Lift trucks when transported on low-bed trailers.
11. Aqua ammonia fertilizer, liquid, when transported in bulk in tank vehicles.
  - A. Between all points and places in the San Francisco Territory, as described in Appendix B attached hereto.
  - B. Between all points on or within 20 miles of the following routes:
    1. U.S. Highways 99, 99-W and 99-E between Stockton and Red Bluff, inclusive.
