

**ORIGINAL**Decision No. 60865

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of  
 San Mateo-Burlingame Transit Company  
 for an order authorizing an on call  
 Passenger Bus Service between the City  
 of San Mateo and the City of Hayward,  
 via the San Mateo-Hayward Bridge.

O P I N I O N

San Mateo-Burlingame Transit Company requests authority to place its service between Hayward and San Mateo on an "on-call" basis, subject to a minimum of 10 passengers and 60 minutes notice, for a period of 18 months.

Service between said points was authorized by Decision No. 56321 dated March 3, 1958. By Decision No. 56926 dated August 1, 1958, applicant was authorized to suspend service for a one-year period because of lack of patronage. On September 2, 1958, service was resumed and service continued until applicant was again authorized to suspend service. (Decision No. 59039 dated September 22, 1959). The last suspension will expire September 22, 1960.

It is alleged that the proposed "on-call" service will allow applicant sufficient time to develop a market for its services, have a limited service available to the public and be relieved of the necessity of providing service that is not compensatory. It is further alleged that prior to the expiration of 18 months applicant will either provide a regular service or request authority to abandon service.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity does not now require applicant's

regular service between San Mateo and Hayward. The application will be granted, and a public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,




IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That after the effective date hereof San Mateo-Burlingame Transit Company may, for a period of 18 months, place its service between Hayward and San Mateo, authorized by Decision No. 56321, on an "on-call" basis, subject to a minimum of 10 passengers and 60 minutes notice.

(2) That within 60 days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission applicant shall amend its tariffs and timetable on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
